2.2. Form of certification of applicants for higher education

The certification of the graduate of the educational-professional program of specialty 231 "Social work" is carried out in the form of a qualification examination on the theory and practice of social work and protection of the bachelor's work and ends with issuing a document of a standard sample awarding them a bachelor's degree with a qualification: Bachelor of Social Work.
