Rector's Foreword

Ternopil Volodymyr Hnatiuk National Pedagogical University (TNPU) is one of the leading centres of higher pedagogical education in Ukraine. According to the Ukrainian higher education institutions consolidated rating 2021, TNPU ranks the first among pedagogical universities. During its functioning the University has prepared more than 70 000 specialists for general secondary, professional, and higher education institutions. The University takes pride in its 65 full professors, 346 PhDs, 15 Doctors Honoris Causa, Academic and Corresponding Members of National Academy of Educational Sciences of Ukraine.



TNPU provides training programs in 89 fields for Bachelor and Master's degrees. Currently, the university pursues linkages with more than 60 partners from 18 countries. Cooperation on conducting research within the framework of international projects realization endures in the fields of STEM, education, foreign languages, and especially flourish in information and communication technology, environmental toxicology and ecology. The students of the University participate in different international academic mobility programs: one-term study, double diploma, various kinds of internship, youth exchanges, etc. Annually, TNPU welcomes the foreign students and staff from partner universities. The University departments hold summer schools on different disciplines which catch interest of international students.

Constant attention of the University administration to logistic support of educational process is the key to success. Our study rooms and laboratories are equipped according to modern standards with visual aids and computers. Students can use library and electronic catalogue with digital versions of publications. There are various leisure and sporting facilities, for example vocal, pop and choreographic groups in the student leisure center. There are six gyms with fitness equipment for arm wrestling and martial-arts. All five halls of residence house three thousand students. The free access is granted at any time.

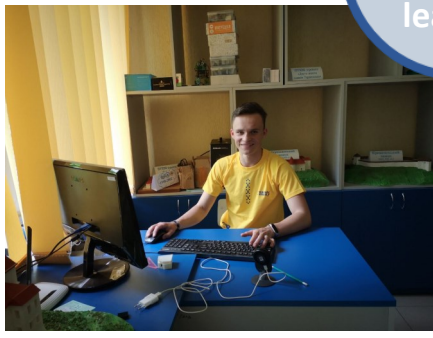

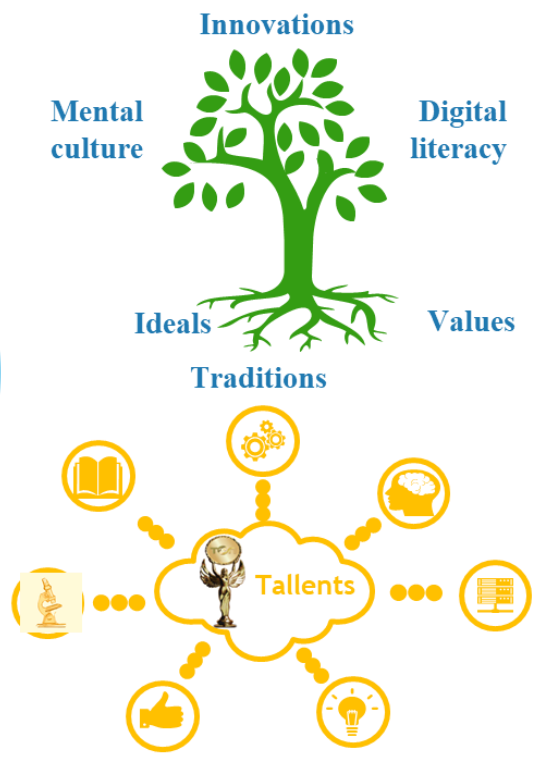

History of Ternopil Volodymyr Hnatiuk National Pedagogical University

1620 — The brotherhood teacher's training school was established in Kremenets.

1637 — The brotherhood school was reorganized into Kremenets-Bohoyavlenk College.

2nd half of the 17th century — Jesuit college (training teachers for Jesuit schools) was founded on the basis of Kremenets-Bohoyavlenk College.

1773 — The Jesuit college in Kremenets was closed.

1783 — Subdistrict and district secular schools, the latter training teachers, were located in the college building.

1805 — The higher educational institution Volyn Higher School of Higher Sciences was founded on the basis of the college building.

1818 — Volyn Higher School was reorganized into Kremenets-Volyn Lyceum.

1833 — Kremenets-Volyn Lyceum was closed. Volyn Theological College was established instead.

1902 — Volyn Eparchy Girl's College which trained teachers for junior pupils was founded on the basis of Volyn Theological College.

1920 — Kremenets Lyceum was reestablished. Teacher's College affiliated with the lyceum was opened.

1935 — The teacher's college was restructured into the Pedagogium.

1937 — Teacher's training lyceum was founded.

1940 — The Teacher's Training Institute was opened on the basis of the former lyceum. For the first time courses were conducted in the Ukrainian language.

1942–1944 — During World War II teachers and students changed the classrooms and books into trenches and rifles.

1944 — Kremenets Institute was again opened for students in September.

1950 — Kremenets Teacher's Training Institute was reorganized into the pedagogical institute according to the resolution of the Ministry Council of Ukraine on August, 4th

1969 — The pedagogical institute was transferred to the city of Ternopil.

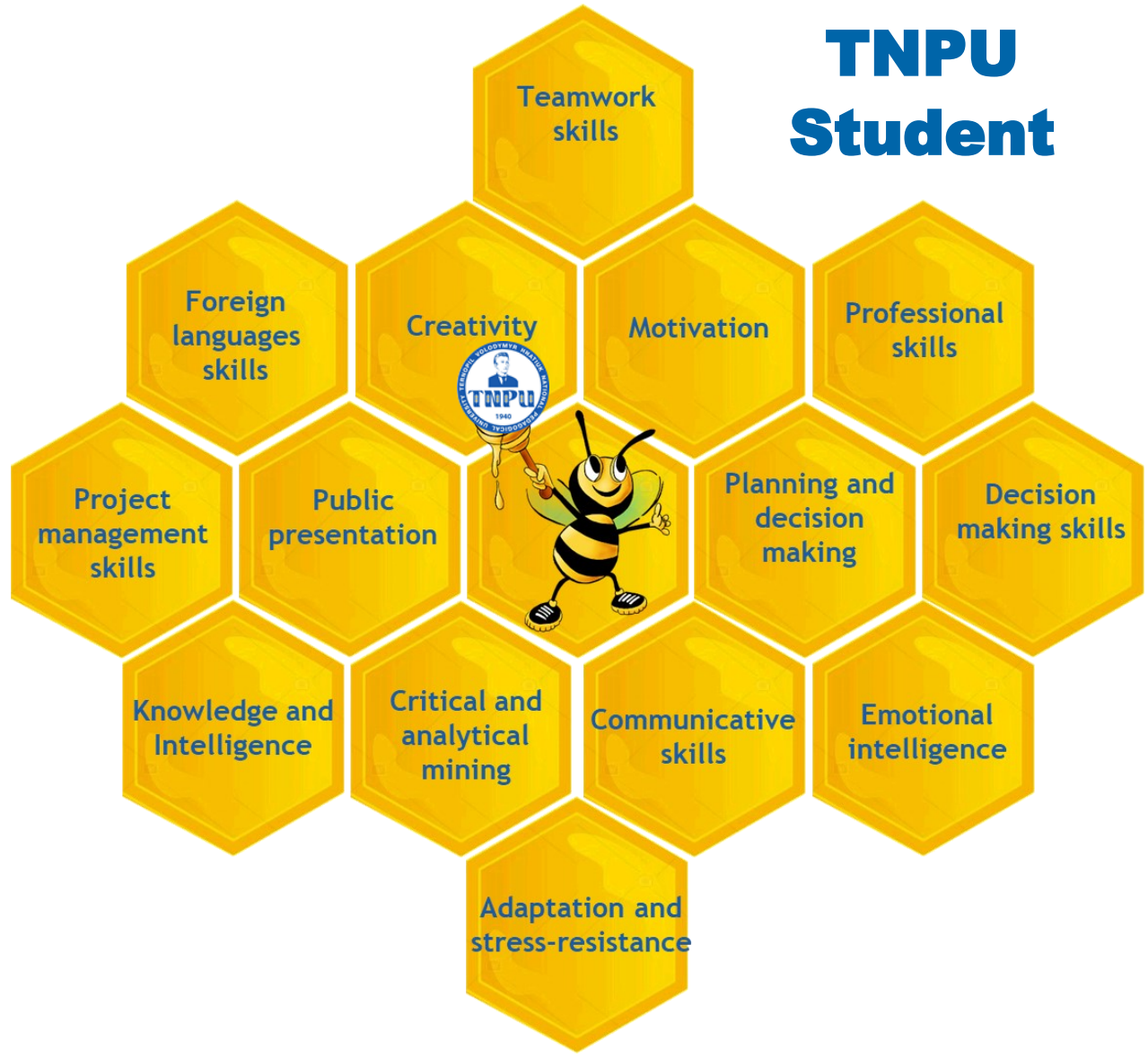
1997 — The pedagogical university was established on the Ternopil Pedagogical Institute basis.

2004 — Ternopil Pedagogical University received the National Educational Institution status according to the President of Ukraine Decree on August 21st, 2004.

TNPU International Relations

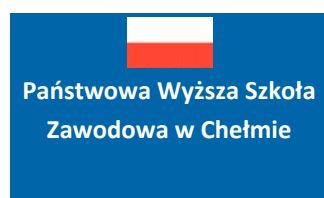
TNPU pursues partnerships with more than 60 higher education institutions worldwide. The cooperation includes joint research projects, double diploma programs, academic mobility programs, and many more. The growth and strengthening of inter-university relations are facilitated by the membership of TNPU in international structures, namely: Consortium of Ukrainian Universities and Warsaw University (since 2006); Academic Association of Central and Eastern Europe (since 2006); Association of Rectors of European Pedagogical Universities; Associations of signatories of the Charter of the Universities (since 2013); Inter-State Educational and Scientific Platform—Eurasian Academic Forum (since 2016).



In 2021, TNPU was honoured with the right to open the first Confucius Institute in Western Ukraine in close cooperation with Shenyang Normal University. We are thoroughly working on the future center which will be a further step in TNPU–China connections.

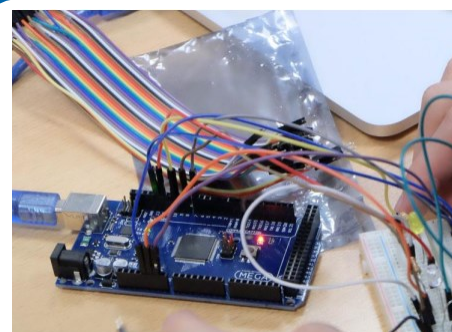
Research Activities

Research at TNPУ covers a very broad spectrum of disciplines with 17 research centers and 28 research labs within the University structure. The research centers are focused on fundamental aspects (majority of the centers represent research in Humanities) which the labs are preoccupied with research and development projects (6 of 28 labs work in Biology and Health Care). The most prominent research fields at TNPУ are the following:

- Environmental Toxicology;
- Ecological Biochemistry;
- Adaptive Learning (personalized and adaptive learning platforms and tools);
- Gaming (educational gaming / video games in education);
- Learning Materials (digital learning resources & e-textbooks);
- Virtual Reality & Augmented Reality in Education;
- AI and Machine Learning in Education;
- Big Data in Education;
- Psychological Mechanisms of Social Environment Building & Gender Equality;
- Plant Biotechnology;
- Inclusive Education;
- Physical Rehabilitation (in terms of individual physical exercises set).

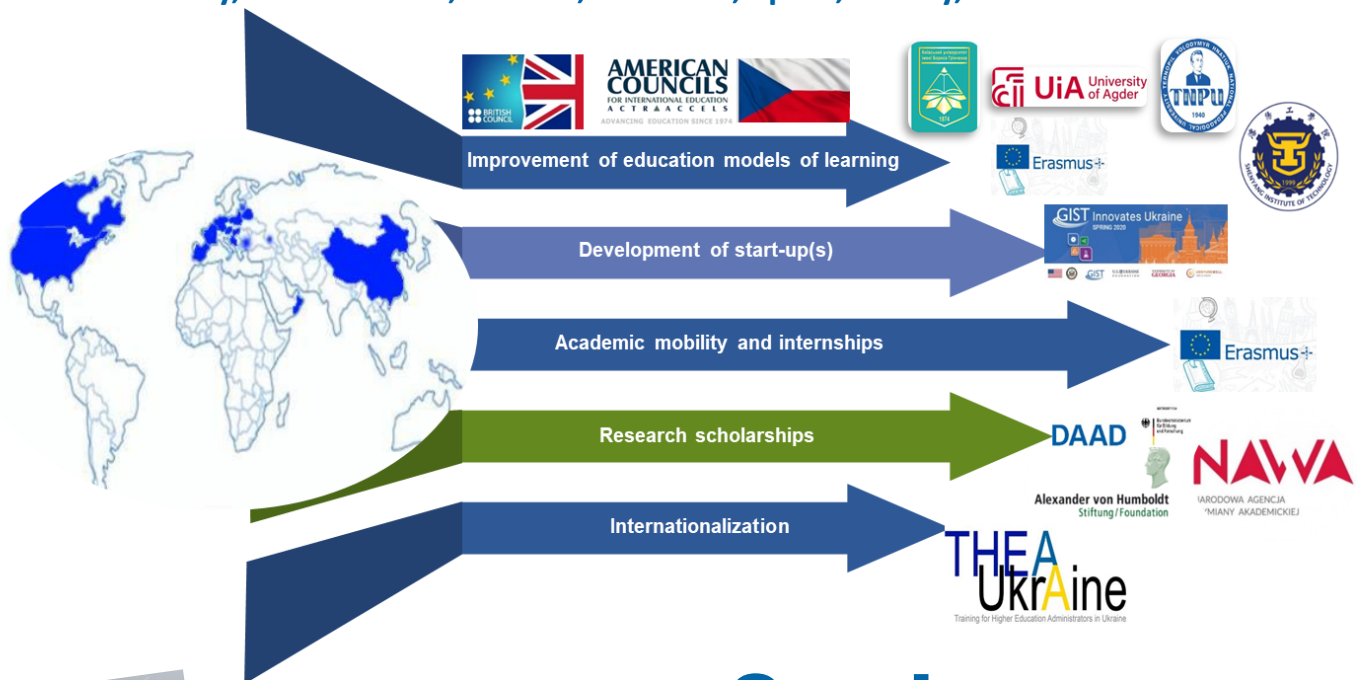
Bachelor and Master's program students are widely engaged into the work of research centers and labs, since the University pays special attention to immersing students into the chosen field research. This ensures better knowledge and skills acquisition.

The research centers and labs play the crucial role in PhD students preparation. In 2021, 147 PhD candidates were gaining best research experience at TNPУ research facilities.

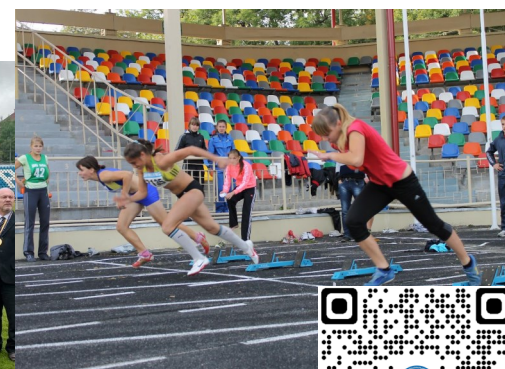


Faculty of Physical Education

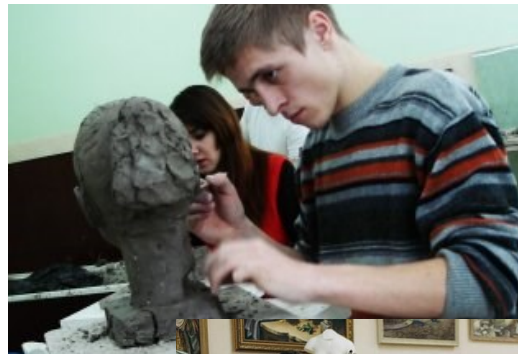
