The conference has been registered with Ukrainian Scientific and Technical Expertise and Information Institute (State research institution in the field of management of Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine). Certification № 354 of September 03, 2020.

Abstracts with main ideas will be published as a part of the collection of scientific articles with the UDC (YДK) number, DOI and ISSN: <u>2617-1449</u>, each paper will have Google Scholar indexing.

The participants will get conference materials and the certificate to confirm their participation in the International conference.

Abstracts (thesis statements) submission requirements

1. Abstracts of the presentation must be structured according to the requirements.

2. Text length of abstracts (thesis statements) must not exceed 6 pages, the page size A4 (297x210 MM), page orientation – portrait orientation.

3. Margins: top, bottom, right, left -20 mm.

4. Fonts: Times New Roman, size -14, line spacing -1,5.

5. Sequence of material disposition in abstracts (thesis statements) is as follows: *number and name of the section, surname and initials of the author(s)* (semibold type

face); *year of study, group, education institution, city/town (italics)*; *academic advisor details; title of the report* (capital letters, semibold type face); text (alignment - full justification with left indent 10 mm, pages are not to be numbered).

6. The reference list should be placed at the end of text named "References". References in the text are enclosed in square brackets with indication of an index number of a source according to the list separated by commas – number of page, for example: [5, c. 57].

IMPORTANT! While making the reference list one must follow the requirements of the National standard of Ukraine dated from 2015, State Standards of Ukraine **8302:2015** «Information and Documentation. Bibliographic references. Fundamental principles and drafting rules».
