- ❖ The conference invites lecturers from domestic and international higher education institutions, teachers, postgraduate students, and higher education students specializing in Germanic, Romance, and Slavic studies, foreign language teaching methodology, and translation studies.
- ❖ Due to the imposition of martial law in Ukraine, participation in the conference may be either in person or remote (in a distance format) using Zoom video communication.
- ❖ All participants will receive an electronic collection of conference materials and a participation certificate (6 hours / 0.2 ECTS) as a form of professional development for academic and research staff, in accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No. 800, dated August 21, 2019.

Official languages of the conference: *Ukrainian, French, English, Polish, German.*

Participant registration deadline: May 12, 2026.

Requirements for conference theses:

- Length: from 2 to 5 A4 pages in Microsoft Word for Windows (versions 6.0, 7.0, 97, 2000, 2003, 2007); Font: Times New Roman, Size: 14; Line spacing: 1.5; Paragraph indent: 1.25 cm; Margins: 2 cm.
- Structure of the theses: conference section according to the topic of the theses (e.g., Section 1. Grammar. Linguopragmatics. Sociolinguistics. Linguoculturology); title of the theses (uppercase letters, bold font); author's surname and initials (bold font); academic degree, academic title (if applicable), position, place of work (study); city of the institution, country; main text.
- The file must be named in Ukrainian according to the participant's surname and initials (e.g., Ivanenko S._theses). *Note: When sending theses by e-mail, the subject line must indicate the conference section corresponding to the topic of the theses.
- The list of sources (without duplicates) should be placed at the end of the text under the heading «Literature:». In-text citations should be marked with square brackets, indicating the source number in the list and, after a comma, the page number(s), e.g., [1, p. 45].
